

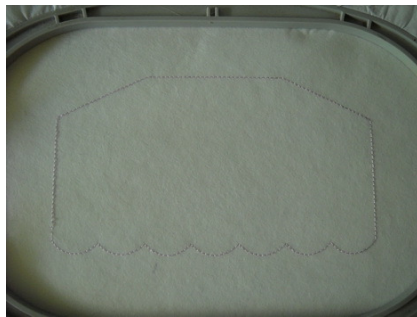
Threads n Scissors

Coat Hanger Bibs

Stitch out two pieces

note color stops have been put into the designs. Use the same color thread where necessary

Hoop 1 layer of cut-away stabilizer. Stitch the first color.



Cut a piece of batting and satin larger than the stitched area and place over the stitched area.



Remove the hoop from the machine and place a piece of printed cotton fabric to the underside of the hoop.



Materials

Cut-away Stabilizer

Thin Batting

Satin

Printed cotton fabric

Embroidery Thread

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Stitch the next color. Remove the hoop from the machine and trim away excess fabric from both sides of the hoop. Stitch the last color.

Stitch two of these pieces.

Now, to put your coat hanger bib together,!

Use your sewing machine, use a zig-zag stitch. Put the two pieces together with the embroidery facing out, and stitch the top slanting sides together, leaving the center of the bib open for the hanger to go through.
