



# Threads n Scissors

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## Continuous Heirloom Lace Trims

These designs have marker stitches already in the design. The marker stitches are the first color. I do mine in the same color as the lace as I don't want the color showing through.

### Method

#### First piece

Hoop 2 layers of water soluble stabilizer. Stitch the first color. Trim jumps and stitch the rest of the design. Trim the design from the stabilizer being careful not to cut any joiners. The joiners are the running stitch tabs on the edge of the design.

#### Second Piece

Hoop 2 layers of water soluble stabilizer. Stitch the first color. Place the first piece's joiner tabs and top bar onto the matching markers. Here you can spray glue or tape the piece of lace in place. (If you want, repeat the first color to hold the design into place. I jump back one color on my machine to do this) stitch the rest of the design.

Continue in this method to create the required length of lace. When you are done, just rinse out the stabilizer and allow it to soak. When the stabilizer is out, lay flat to dry and you are ready to use your lace.

Some of these designs have place to thread ribbon through. This is optional.

### Materials

**Water soluble stabilizer ( I use the non woven kind)**

**Embroidery Thread**



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
