

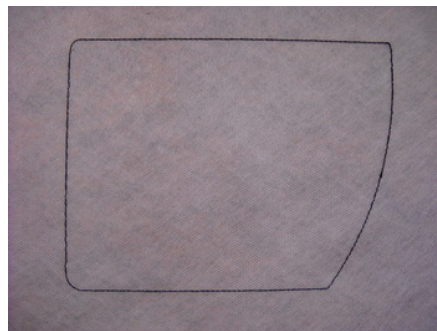


Threads n Scissors

Country Sunglasses Holder

Color stops have been put into the design. Use a single color throughout except for the stipple. Be sure to use a matching color for the bobbin thread, especially when stitching the edgings. This keeps the design looking tidy.

Hoop 2 layers of water soluble stabilizer. Stitch the first color. This is a dyeline.



Materials

Water Soluble Stabilizer

Black Fabric

Tapestry Weave Fabric

Embroidery Thread

Cut a piece of black fabric 15 cm x 20 cm and place it over the dyeline. Stitch the next color. This holds the fabric in place. Stitch the next color. This is a dyeline. Cut a piece of tapestry weave fabric 10 cm x 15 cm and place it over the dyeline. Stitch the next color. Trim away excess tapestry weave fabric.



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Change color (I used a deep red) and stitch the next color (stipple pattern) Change back to the first color and stitch the next color. This neatens off the edge between the stipple stitching and the tapestry weave fabric.



Cut a piece of black fabric 15 cm x 20 cm and place it on the underside of the design. Stitch the next. This lines the inside of the front piece of the sunglasses case. Remove the hoop from the machine and trim away excess fabric from both sides of the hoop. Stitch the next color. This will neatens off the top edge of the tapestry weave fabric. Stitch the next color. This is a dyeline. Cut a piece of black fabric and tapestry weave fabric 15 cm x 20 cm and place them on the underside of the hoop covering the design. Use masking tape to hold the fabric in place. Make sure that the wrong sides of the fabric are to the inside with the right sides face outward. Stitch the next color. This holds the fabric in place. Remove the hoop from the machine and trim away excess fabric. Now stitch the last color.



Remove the design from the stabilizer. Rinse out the water soluble stabilizer thoroughly and leave to dry. Your sunglasses case is complete.
