## Fabric Photo Print Tutorial

### Method

**Printing on fabric should be done with an ink jet printer only!!!**

If the fabric is going to be washed, pre-treat the fabric using Bubble Jet Set. Follow the manufacturers instructions for pre-treating the fabric.

Cut the fabric larger than an A4 page. Cut a piece of Freezer Paper the same size. Place the wax side down onto the fabric and using a hot iron, iron the freezer paper to the fabric. Once the freezer paper is bonded to the fabric, cut the fabric to the size of an A4 page. Place the fabric into the paper feed and print the photo of your choice onto the fabric. Let the ink dry. Using a hot iron, iron the print to help set the ink.

Using your own printed fabric for embroidery projects is a great way to add your own creativity to your embroidery projects.

### Materials

Fabric

Freezer Paper

Iron

**Bubble Jet Set to treat the fabric to prevent the inks from fading and washing out**



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
