## Fingerless Gloves

### Method

Hoop 1—2 layers of water soluble vilene. Cut two pieces of fleece 12 inches x 8 inches. Load the one glove design onto your embroidery machine. Place both pieces of fleece onto your hoop so half is on the vilene and half is off the side of the hoop. This piece will be folded into the design later.

Important: If you are stitching the left glove, the excess fabric must lie to the left of the hoop.

If you are stitching the right glove, the excess fabric must lie to the right of the hoop.

This tutorial shows the left glove. The excess fabric hangs over the left side of the hoop. **The stretch of the fleece must be along the length and not the short side.**

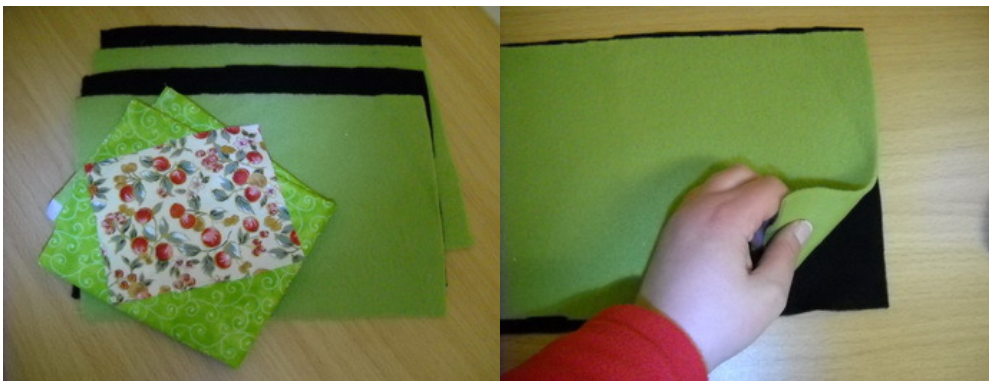
### Materials

**Water Soluble Vilene**

**Fleece**

**Printed Polycotton**

**Embroidery Thread**



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The designs are done in applique. Color stops have been included in the design. Here's how the applique is done:

The first step of applique stitches a running line to mark where to put the fabric.



Place a piece of printed fabric over the running edge. Stitch the next color. This tacks down the fabric with a zig-zag type stitch.



Trim the excess printed fabric and stitch the next color. This will be a satin edging stitch.



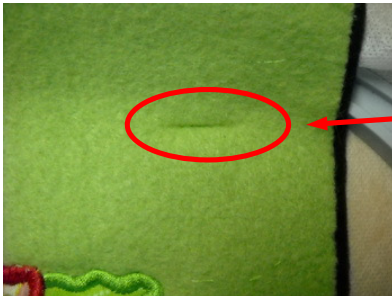
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The design will continue in this method until all applique is done and then will stitch the detail in. eg. Eyes, flowers, flower centres etc.



When the applique part is done, there will be 2 color changes left f the glove design. Using a matching thread color to the fleece used, stitch the second to last color. These mark the fold for the fleece. Take the hoop out of the machine and fold the excess fleece over the design. The fold will be on the stitches you have just stitched.



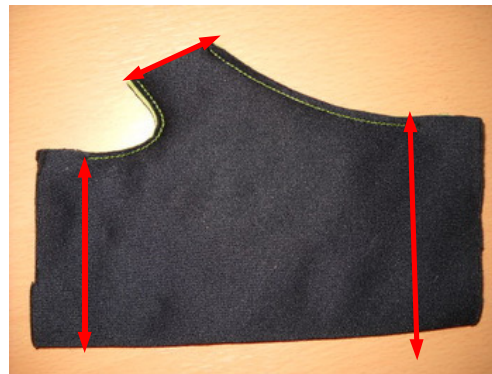
**Second color stitches.**

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Stitch the last color. Remove the stabilizer. I cut off as much vilene before wash any left out. Cut the glove as shown in the picture. Cut the top and base of the glove as shown by the red lines.



Now cut small strips into the top and bottom of the glove to fringe the edges. Turn the glove right side out.

Use this method to make both gloves, rembering to leave the excess of the fleece fabric to either right or left side of the hoop depending on the glove you are making.
