

Heart Gift Boxes

Method

Stitch out 2 x Design 1 and 2 x Design 2

Design 1 pieces

Hoop 2 layers of water soluble stabilizer. Stitch the first color.



Place a piece of cutaway stabilizer, thin batting and satin fabric over the stitch area







Materials

Thin Batting

Cutaway Stabilizer

Satin Fabric

Water Soluble Stabilizer

Embroidery Thread

Masking tape or temporary adhesive spray


Hot glue to assemble

Ribbon

Stitch the next 2 colors.







Place two pieces of cutaway and one piece of satin fabric to the underside of the design





Stitch the next color. Cut away excess fabric from both sides of the hoop. Stitch the last color.







Design 2

Hoop 1 layer of cutaway stabilizer. Stitch the first color. Place a piece of thin batting and a piece of satin fabric over the stitched area. Stitch the next two colors.









Place two pieces of cutaway stabilizer and a piece of satin fabric to the underside of the design. Use masking tape or temporary adhesive spray to hold in place. Stitch the next color. Trim away excess fabric from both sides of the hoop and stitch the last color.

Assembling the box



Rinse out the water soluble stabilizer on the Design 1 pieces. Leave to dry completely before assembling.

Heat up you glue gun. Glue the two sides as shown in the photos below.










For the Lid

Cut two pieces of ribbon and glue half of each piece to the wrong side of the lid.



Place the lid on the box and glue the other half of the ribbons to the back of the box.





Trim off any excess ribbon. Glue on ribbon bows, string beads etc to finish off the box if wanted.
