Hungarian Wing Needle Tea Cloth



Materials

**Even Weave Linen
26" x 22"**

**Water soluble stabili-
lizer**

Wing Needle

Embroidery Threads

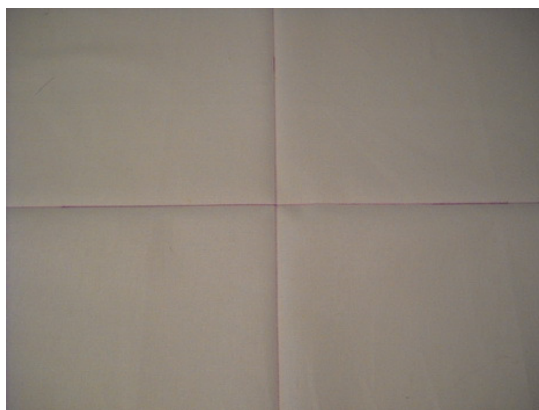
Fabric Marker

Ruler

Design Printouts

Cut out your design printouts. Design printouts usually have the center of the design marked.

Prepare your fabric by ironing out any creases. Fold the fabric in half and press. Fold the fabric in half in the opposite direction to the first fold and press. Open the cloth and using the ruler and fabric marker, mark the crease folds

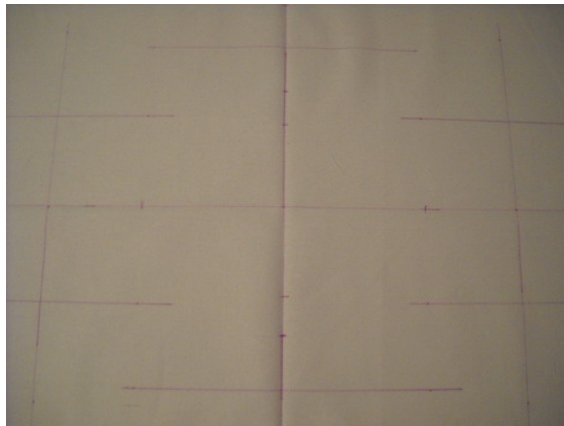


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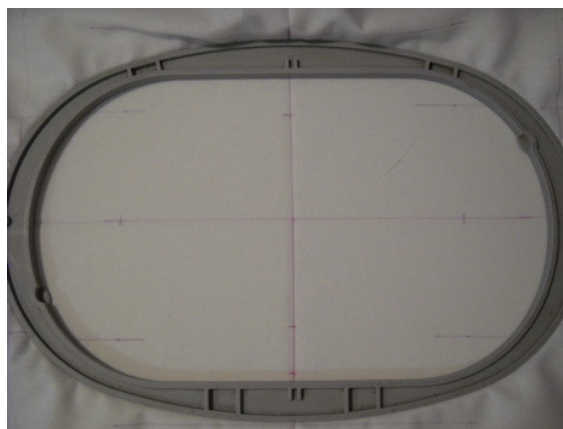
Place your print outs where you want them. You may need to measure from the creases for symmetry.



I start by placing the center design and arrange the corners and side designs around the center design. Mark the center of each design. I usually extend these lines to help with the hooping of the fabric.



Hoop your fabric with two layers of water soluble stabilizer.



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You are now ready to stitch out your design.
