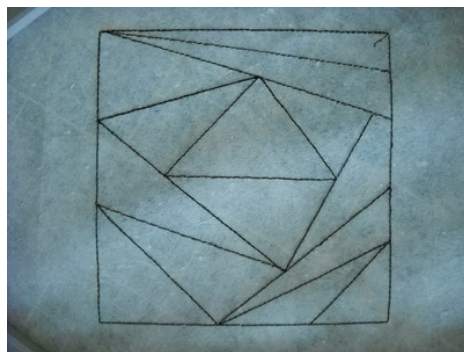

## Crazy Patch

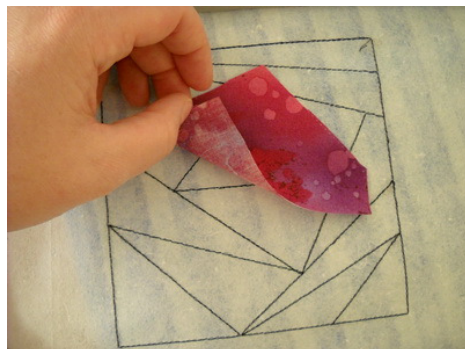
Crazy Patch is a great way to use up left over pieces of fabric. You don't require large pieces for this. Each block is made entirely In The Hoop, making quilting super easy.

### Method

Hoop 1 layer of tear away stabilizer. Stitch the first color. This is the foundation of where the pieces of fabric will go and will show the size of the piece.



Stitch the next color. This marks the start of the crazy patch. Place a piece of fabric larger than the stitched area.



### Materials

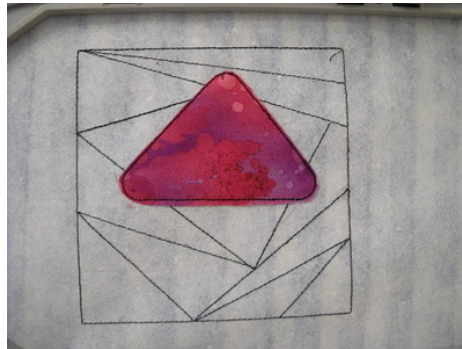
- Tear away stabilizer**
- Pieces of quilting fabric**
- Mini Iron or finger press**



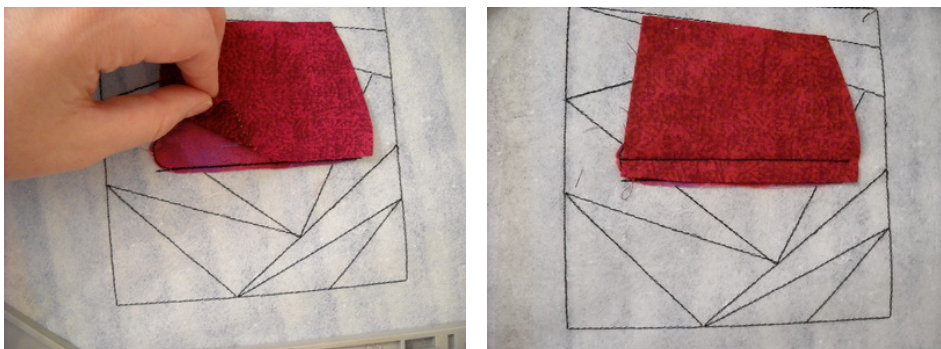
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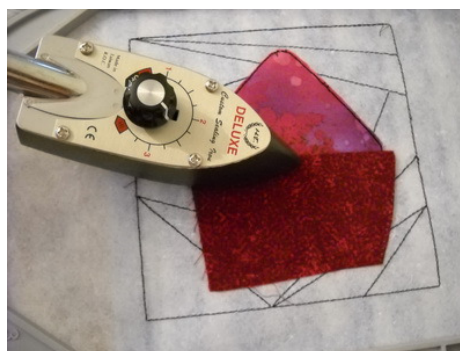
Stitch the next color. This holds the first piece in place. The rest of the pieces will be added to this piece.  
Trim fabric from around the stitching.



Stitch the next color. This marks where the next piece is to go. These are the placement stitches. Cut a piece of fabric larger than the piece marked. Place right sides together and stitch the next color. This creates the seam.



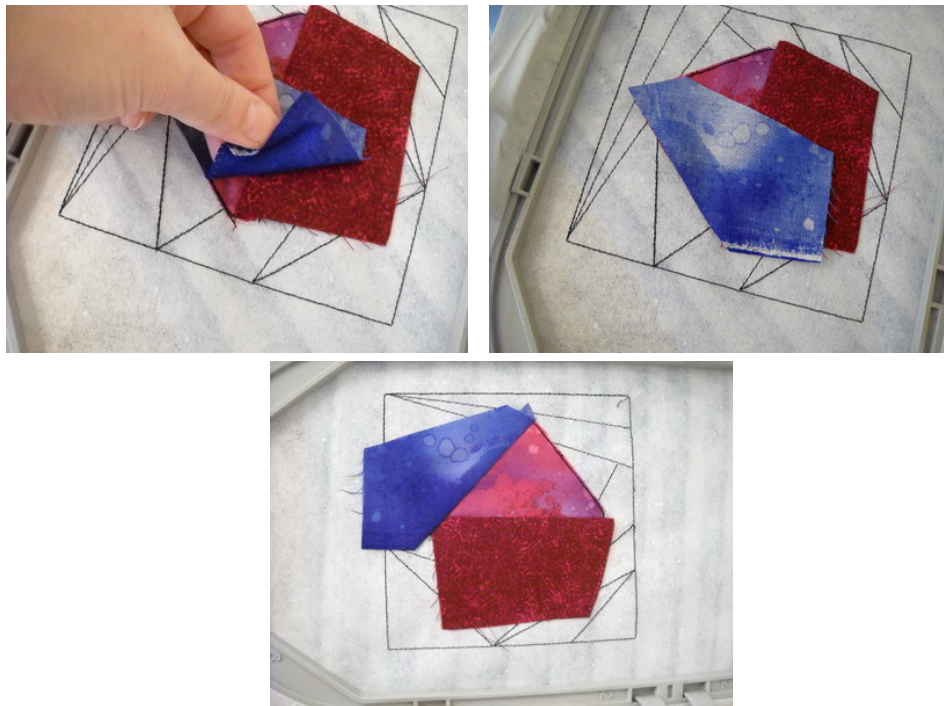
Flip the piece over and finger press or press with the mini iron.



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Stitch the next color. Again place a piece of fabric larger than the area to be covered, right sides together. Stitch the next color—the seam stitch.



Continue in this method to build up the block.. You may want to trim excess fabric from the fabric placement stitches as you go. It does make it easier.

When your block is complete, using your rotary cutter and ruler, trim the block to your required size.



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
