

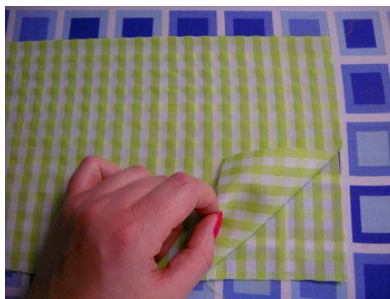
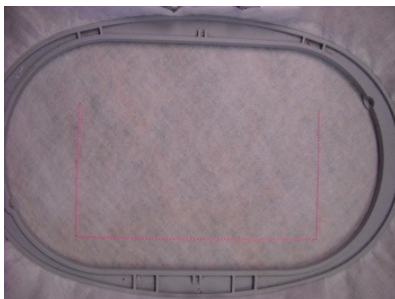
Threads n Scissors

Junior Craft Caddy

Method

Color stops have been put in. I used one color throughout the design. Please use colors of your choice.

Hoop two layers of water soluble stabilizer. Stitch the first color. This is a dye. Cut a piece of fabric double the width of the stitched area and fold it in half. Press the folded edge. Place the folded edge on the open side of the dye line. Use masking tape to hold in place. Stitch the next color.



Stitch the next color. This is another dye line. Cut another piece of fabric and fold it in half. Press the folded edge and place the folded edge on the open side of the new dye line. Use masking tape to hold in place and stitch the next color.



Materials

Water soluble stabilizer

Printed cotton fabrics

Ribbon for handle

Hook and loop tape

Masking tape

Threads n Scissors

Stitch the next color. This is another dye line. Cut two piece of fabric and with wrong sides together place on the under-side of the hoop. Use masking tape to hold into place. Stitch the next color.



Stitch the next color. This is a dye line for the inside pocket. Cut a piece of fabric and fold it in half. Press the folded edge and place the folded edge on the open side of the dye line. Use masking tape to hold it in place and stitch the next color.



Stitch the next color. This tacks all the pieces of fabric together. Trim away excess fabric from both sides of the hoop. Stitch the next color. This will be a satin edging and a dye line for the handle positions.



Cut a piece of ribbon 10 inches long. Place each end onto the dye lines and tape in place. Cut a strip of fabric and place of the ribbon on the dye lines. Tape in place and stitch the next color. Trim away excess fabric and stitch the last color.



Make two of these and stitch along the bottom of the design. Glue hook and loop tape in both corners to close the caddy.
