## Ponytail Covers



Stitch out using the Basic Applique method

### Basic Applique Method

(Colour stops have been put into the design—the first two colour changes and the last two colour changes form the borders of the design pieces. Use the same colour. Colour charts have been given as a guide for the colours. Mix and match colours of your choice to make your own unique ponytail covers

Hoop a single layer of cut away stabilizer. Stitch the first colour. Cut a piece of thin batting and a piece of satin fabric and place them both over the stitched area, the batting first and then the satin. Stitch the next colour. This holds the fabric and batting in place. Stitch the motif. There should be two colour changes left

### Materials

Cutaway stabilizer

Satin Fabric

Thin Batting

Temporary adhesive spray

Cuticle Sticks



Remove the hoop from the machine and trim away excess satin and batting from around the design. Stitch the next colour. Remove the hoop from the machine. Cut a piece of satin fabric and put onto the underside of the hoop.

Use temporary adhesive to hold into place. Stitch the last colour. Cut the piece out of the stabilizer.. Cut out the holes and push a cuticle stick through
