Pot Holder Instructions

Method:

1. Hoop a Double Layer of Water Soluble Vilene (WSV). Stitch the first colour of the design.

2.

Place a piece of Heatex Batting onto the stitched area and then cover the batting with a piece of printed cotton fabric.

2. Stitch out the Second Colour - this will be an outline of the Design Piece.

3. Stitch out the motif/patterning. Before the second to last colour, remove the

hoop from the machine. Turn the hoop over so that the back is facing upwards.

Place a piece of ribbon and then a piece of Printed Cotton onto the back of the hoop. Keep it in place by using a little fabric adhesive.

4. Return the hoop to the machine and stitch out the second to last colour - this is an outline of the design piece.
5. Remove the hoop from the machine and trim away the excess fabric from around the design piece outline at the front and at the back of the hoop.
6. Replace the hoop in the machine and stitch out the final colour - this is the satin stitch edging.

Rinse out the water soluble stabilizer - soak the pot holder well to remove all the stabilizer. Allow to dry.

Materials:

Water Soluble Stabilizer
Heatex Batting
Ribbon
Printed Cotton Fabric
Embroidery Thread (I used Marathon Thread)
Temporary Adhesive Spray



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
