

Instructions for Towel Toppers



Hoop 1 layer of cutaway stabilizer. Stitch the first color. Place a piece of batting and a piece of cotton fabric over the stitching. Stitch the rest of the design, leaving the last 2 colors unstitched.

Materials

Cutaway stabilizer

Thin batting

Cotton fabric

Button

Embroidery Thread

Kitchen towel

Temporary Adhesive Spray







Remove the hoop from the machine. Place a piece of fabric on the backside of the hoop. Use the temporary adhesive spray to hold the fabric in place. Stitch the second to last color. Remove the hoop from the machine and trim away excess fabric from around the design on both sides of the hoop. Stitch the last color. Trim out of the stabilizer







Assemble

Fold the towel almost in half. Pleat the kitchen tea towel so it fits the topper. Baste the pleats. Using a zigzag stitch on your sewing machine, stitch the towel to the topper. Lastly open the button hole and sew a button to the back of the topper.
