

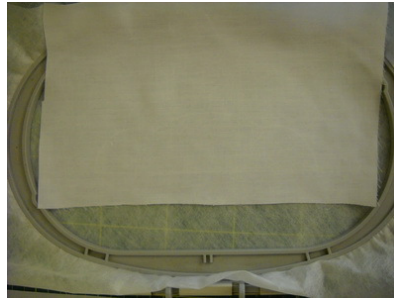
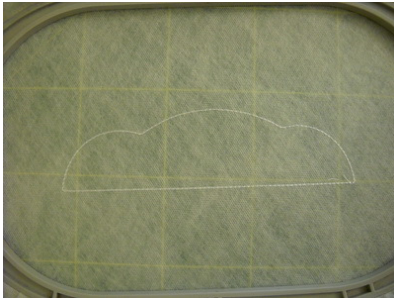

Vintage Crochet and Fabric Edgings

Method

Hoop 2 layers of water soluble stabilizer. Stitch the first color. This marks where to place the fabric. Cut a piece of cotton fabric and place it over the stitched area. Stitch the second color. This holds the fabric in place.



Materials

Cotton fabric

Water soluble stabilizer

Embroidery Thread

Thin ribbon (optional)

Stitch the rest of the design leaving the last color. **DO NOT STITCH THE LAST COLOR CHANGE.**

Cut the fabric from around the stitching. Stitch the last color.



Stitch as many as you need. Trim around the design. Using your sewing machine and a zig-zag stitch, stitch the pieces together. Rinse out the stabilizer. If the design allows for ribbon to be threaded through, thread ribbon through the ribbon holes. Your lace edgings are now ready to be put onto towels, linen, pillowcases and many other items.
