

Baby Mobile

Tip When hooping water soluble stabilizer, place them so that two of the layers are at right angles to each other and the other layers are diagonal. This helps prevent the stabilizer from stretching.

***Note.** Colour stops have been put in. Use the same colour where needed.

Applique upper (Pieces TS035 Designs 1– 5)

1. Hoop 2 layers of water soluble stabilizer. Stitch the first colour. Remove hoop from the machine. Cut a piece of thin batting and satin fabric larger than the stitched area. Lightly spray it with temporary adhesive spray and press it into place, covering the stitched area. Stitch the next colour.



2. Stitch out the motif following the colour chart



3. Remove the hoop from the machine and place a piece of satin to the underside of the design. Use temporary adhesive spray to hold the satin in place. Stitch the next colour. Remove the hoop from the machine and trim away the excess fabric from both sides of the hoop



Materials

Water soluble Stabilizer

Satin

Thin Batting

Epoxy coated wire

Ribbon

Temporary Adhesive Spray

Embroidery Thread

Pliers

Cable Ties

Helpful Tip

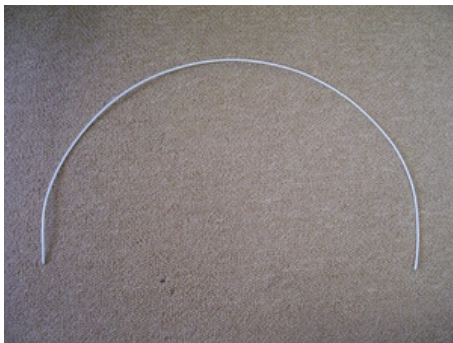
If you have a larger hoop for your machine, put as many designs that can be fitted into the hoop. This saves on stabilizer

3. Stitch the last colour. Stitch out all the mobile pieces. Rinse out the water soluble stabilizer and allow to dry.



Assembling the Baby Mobile

1. Cut two lengths of epoxy coated wire using pliers. You can make them any length you want and bend them into an arc. Using your pliers, make a loop at either end of the wire and use a cable tie to hold the loop closed.



2. Criss-cross the two arcs and use a cable tie to attach them together in the middle. Now cut lengths of ribbon and tie the mobile rocking horses to the loops at the ends of the arcs and one to the centre of the mobile. To hang the mobile up, tie a ribbon to the middle of the mobile where the two arcs join to make a loop for hanging.

* Idea * You can also decorate the mobile arcs with bells or large disc beads. If you use beads, make sure they are firmly attached or that baby can't pull on the mobile to take them off
