Basic Guide to Stitching Lace

Wind a bobbin with matching thread that is to be used for the upper thread. Always use a new needle before starting a lace project.. A blunt needle will damage the stabilizer and cause the lace not to stitch properly. Always store the water soluble in a dry place.

Hoop a minimum of two layers of stabilizer. If you are using a big hoop, you will need an extra layer of stabilizer.

Hoop two to three layers of water soluble stabilizer. Stitch out the design. Stitch out all the required pieces of lace for your project. Use your sewing machine with a zig-zag stitch and sew the pieces together. Stitch the lace to your project and then rinse out the stabilizer from the lace.
