

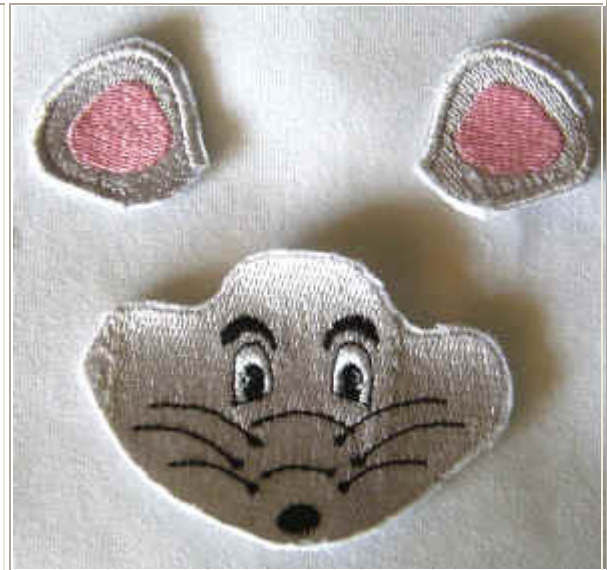
To Make the Moccasin

Materials:

- Water Soluble Vilene
- Avalon - Water Soluble Aqua Film
- Fleece
- Temporary Spray Adhesive - 505
- Embroidery Threads



Hoop two layers of water soluble vilene. Spray 505 onto vilene and "stick" a piece of fleece 4" x 4" to vilene. Spray 505 onto fleece and "stick" a piece of Avalon onto fleece. This stops the stitches from going into the fleece. Stitch out design. Trim away excess fleece. Do the same with the ears.



Hoop two layers of water soluble vilene. Spray 505 onto vilene and "stick" a piece of fleece 4" x 4" to vilene. Stitch outline of side of moccasin. Keeping vilene and design in hoop, trim away excess fleece. **DO NOT REMOVE FROM HOOP.**



Spray 505 onto side of moccasin and "stick" matching ear piece into position.



Spray 505 onto side of moccasin and ear and "stick" face piece into position.



Put a piece of Avalon on top of design. If necessary, lightly spray area with 505.



Stitch out remainder of design



Carefully remove from hoop. If a piece of the face shows near the ear, using a sharp pair of scissors, carefully trim the excess off.

Using this method complete the other side of the moccasin.

All that is left now is to stitch the back seam using bias binding and to stitch the sole to the moccasin

also using bias binding. The sole of the moccasin is stitched out the same way as the face and ears.
