Citrus Coasters with Bias Binding Edge



Stitch out several of these in a variety of colors.

Method

Hoop 1 layer of cutaway stabilizer. Stitch the first color (I used the same color throughout the design). Remove the hoop and place a piece of fabric over the stitched area. Use temporary adhesive spray to hold in place. Stitch the rest of the design until there is 1 color left.

Materials

Cutaway stabilizer

Cotton Fabric of choice

Temporary Adhesive Spray

Clear Plastic used for table cloths

Bias Binding



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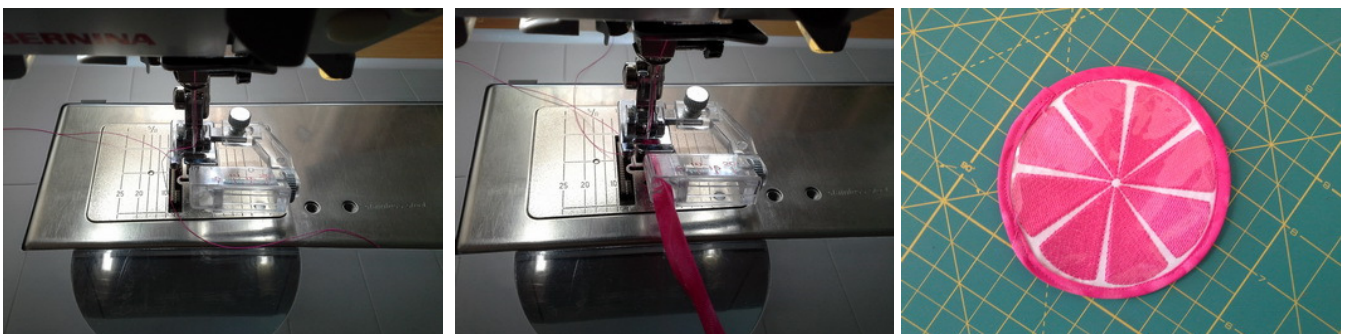
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Remove the hoop from the machine. Turn the hoop over to the back side. Place a piece of fabric over the design and use temporary adhesive to hold in place. Turn the hoop over to the right side. Place a piece of plastic over the design. Stitch the last color. Cut the design out closely to the outer stitching.



Now to add the bias binding. This is super easy if you have a bias binding foot for your machine. I am using the adjustable bias binding foot here. Thread your bias binding through the foot according to the manufacturer's instructions. Use matching bobbin and upper thread. Set your sewing machine to a running stitch. Place the coaster into the foot and sew the bias binding to the coaster. And your coaster is done!!! Stitch a dozen in all your favourite colors. These are ideal for round the BBQ. They are easy to clean and prevent all those nasty water rings and sticky rings on table tops.



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
